- **Adults** must compete at a minimum of 3 Northern Association Shows
- **Juniors** must compete at a minimum of 2 Northern Association Shows
- **Adult Age** – from the beginning of the year the Exhibitor turns 18 years (and over)
- **Junior Age** – 5 to 17 years (from the beginning of the year the Exhibitor turns 5 to the end of the year he/she turns 17)
- **Aggregate Points** to be calculated using:
1st – 5points, 2nd – 3 points, 3rd – 1 point

ENTRY CONDITIONS

1. Exhibits must be bona-fide grown or produced by the Exhibitor.
2. All Exhibits must be clearly branded with the Section No., Class No. and Variety.
3. The Society reserves the right to amend entries if they are entered in the wrong class.
4. Grain, which in the opinion of the Judges, has been submitted to any process that reduces germinating power, will be disqualified.
5. Grain is to be shown in a 2 litre ice cream container full.
6. Any entries of grain that have been picked will be disqualified.
7. Any grain entries contaminated with weevil will be disqualified.
8. No competitor to take more than one prize, in one class, with the same variety of produce.

9. All produce entered must be current season.
10. Only hard, APW and soft varieties accepted by Australian Wheat Board standards will be judged.
11. To be judged on Australian Barley/Australian Wheat Board receival standards.
